

TASK ZERO

BUILD AN INFLATABLE OBJECT



The winter school **fold fly inflate** is a one week design workshop, in which we want to explore and develop inflatable objects: balloons with a surrounding of a lightweight fabric, using air as its supporting structure, forcing the inflatable to grow.

As task zero, you should build an inflatable object as the starting point for the winter school. It can either be a prototype or a model communicating your idea or concept. Give it a function, that determines how it is being inflated, if and how it moves and in which environment it works. You are free in the choice of material and size. The best students will be accepted to the class. The workshop will be a collaboration with the ETSAE Cartagena (Spain) Feng Chia University Taichung (Taiwan) and ETSAM Madrid (Spain).
